P & F DISCO – STUDENT DISCIPLINE – THE RULES

For any parents new to the school, and for those who may not be aware, please read the rules of the disco. Failure to comply with these rules may see the disco suspended or cancelled.

To maintain the duty of care required and to comply with Evacuation Procedures, the following must occur:

ALL STUDENTS MUST SIGN IN OR BE SIGNED IN BY A PARENT

- Kindy children **must** be supervised by a parent for the duration of the disco.
- A minimum of 4 parents from each year group needs to attend and supervise the disco. Any year group without this level of supervision will not be permitted to attend.
- **Younger siblings** and **students not enrolled** at Queen of Apostles are not covered by the school’s insurance and so **are not permitted inside the hall** for the duration of the disco. Very young siblings may enter but must remain seated in a pram or similar.
- Running inside the hall is dangerous and is not allowed. Supervisors will ask any child who is running or otherwise behaving in an inappropriate manner to stop, and may ask them to leave the dance floor if they do not comply.
- Students from Year 3-Year 6 are not permitted inside the hall during the Junior Disco.
- Likewise, students from Kindy – Year 2 are not allowed inside the hall during the Senior Disco.
- Students from Years 3-6 are not permitted to roam through the car park, on the oval or between the school buildings, before, during or after either disco.

It is also important to be aware that the volunteers who supervise the disco are NOT there to supervise your child. They are there to ensure the smooth running of the event. Your entry fee of \$2 or \$3 covers the cost of drinks, snacks and ONE glowstick per child.
